OUR PROGRAM

The Aspire program offers students academic extension opportunities across the Humanities, English, Mathematics and Science (HEMS) curriculum areas.

Year 7 students study in extension classes covering all HEMS subjects and from Year 8 are given the chance to specialise in one to four of these classes depending on their aptitude and interest. The program provides enriched learning experiences that are tailored to developing and advancing students' knowledge, understanding, and skills in a dynamic, challenging and supportive classroom environment.

Studies in the lower school curriculum positions our students to excel in ATAR pathways with previous students going on to study engineering, law, psychology, education, criminology and other STEM careers.

OPPORTUNITIES

Aspire students are encouraged to participate in competitions that will challenge them and provide external feedback on their progress whilst encouraging them to strive for excellence. In addition, students engage in engage in extension activities aimed at supporting study skills and Twenty First Century thinking skills, developing real world learning opportunities and encouraging a philanthropic mindset.

Students are invited to participate in incursion and excursions that build resilience, courage and creativity, including an adventure camp held at Point Walter recreation centre.

Through strong partnerships with UWA, Aspire students are offered WACE revision support in Year 12 and access to scholarships and assistance through programs like Fairway, and Broadway UWA.
